### **Digital Journal:**

We will still do a journal/warm-up, but it will be in the form of a Google Slide. The digital journal slide will be assigned **weekly** and will consist of three items that need to be completed. The items will consist of: *Creative Writing, Word of the Week, Figurative Language, Famous Inspiration, Critical Thinking, & Something I learned this Week*. You will notice this is the **same** thing we were doing in class on our paper copies, I have just created a digital version.

### **Assignments:**

Assignments for ELA will be posted weekly every **Monday in Google Classroom** and will be due that Friday by 9am (unless otherwise noted). If assignments are submitted after 9am on Friday, they will be considered late. Assignments will consist of a combination of reading passages, comprehension questions, and skill work. I will also post mini lesson videos as guidance or tutorials since I can't guide you in person. Most of the assignments will be work you have seen and done before.
